The village chickens can start out with Zamfeed Broiler Starter, then Zamfeed Broiler Grower and Zamfeed Broiler Maintenance.

Broiler and village chicken performance is highly dependent on good management practices. Ensure birds are not stressed, are properly vaccinated, litter is well managed, shelter has adequate ventilation, there are enough feeders and drinkers and that birds are not over-crowded. Ensure birds have access to unlimited clean water.
